When the right equipment is in place, it can reduce stress, reduce risk, and make everyday life more manageable for both the person living with ALS and the people supporting them. Making Moments is about celebrating those everyday wins. It is about helping people keep doing the things that bring them comfort, connection, and joy. It is about supporting caregivers so they can spend more time being a spouse, a child, a parent, or a friend, and less time trying to navigate ALS alone. It is about making sure someone can stay at home longer, sleep safely, move comfortably, communicate clearly, and continue participating in life.
